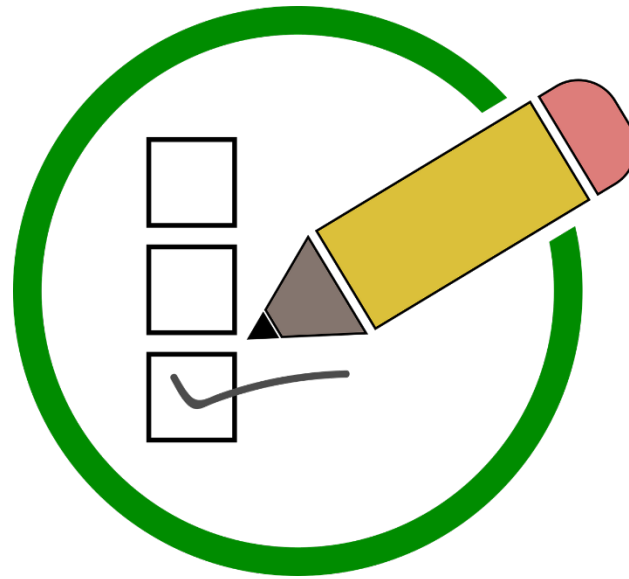

- Increase cost/msy (federal funds)
- Expand eligibility to serve
- Multi-lingual recruitment tools
- Cash award option (vs education award)
- Eliminate or raise the 20% training cap
- Bring back “member measures”
- Reimagine early exits for work and school
