Dialogues in Action

- Offering "Project Impact," an evaluation capacity building training where program teams of 3-4 will be guided to complete a mixed methods outcome evaluation
- Open to any Serve WA program but highly encouraged for Formula grantees
- Could provide up to preliminary evidence in grant
- Cost: \$5,000 that Serve WA would reimburse for Formula funded programs
- Timeline: budget for it in your 2023-2024 budget and the training would take place around January-June 2024
